

**Resolution by the Town Board of the Town of Lake George
Rescinding Resolution #44-2021 Approving the
Establishment of a Town-wide Ambulance District**

Resolution #84-2021

On a motion made by Board Member Stannard, and seconded by Board Member Hurley,

WHEREAS, the Lake George Town Board passed Resolution #44-2021, Approving the Establishment of a Town-Wide Ambulance District on March 8, 2021, and

WHEREAS, as required by New York State Law, Resolution #44-2021 subjected the establishment of the Town-wide Ambulance District to a permissive referendum, and

WHEREAS, a Petition determined by the Town Clerk to meet the statutory requirements was filed within the thirty (30) days permissive referendum period which would result in a special election to be held between July 5, 2021 and July 20, 2021; and

WHEREAS, New York State Town Law §94, allows any resolution subject to a permissive referendum pursuant to Town Law to be submitted to a mandatory referendum at the option of the Town Board, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board plans to either exercise their option of submitting this resolution to a mandatory referendum at the general election to be held on November 2, 2021 to maximize public participation or determine to not form such special district; and

WHEREAS if the Town Board does not establish such Ambulance District or the voters vote to reject the establishment of the Ambulance District, then the cost of such services would remain as it always has been; as a Town general fund expense and be part of the normal Town budget process;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Resolution #44-2021 Approving the Establishment of a Town-wide Ambulance District be rescinded; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that if the Town Board determines to move forward this year with the formation of the Ambulance District, the Town Board plans to adopt a resolution approving the establishment of a Town-wide Ambulance District, subject to a mandatory referendum not more than 105 days before the general election, but not less than 90 days before the general election, so such vote could be part of the general election to be held November 2, 2021 to maximize public participation.


