Rules of Use for Usher Park

Tobacco Free

The Town of Lake George has this facility available for the citizens of the Town. For the greatest enjoyment by all, the Town requests that users of the park follow the park rules and comply by highest standards of behavior and respect of others.

1. A reservation for the use of a pavilion applies only to the specific pavilion reserved, not the entire park. The remaining sections of the park will be available for others. Failure to show up or contact Park Staff (Phone: 668 0034) within one hour after reservation is to begin will result in forfeiture of the reservation of the pavilion, and the use of the facility will be given to the general public.
2. Hours of availability of the park are from 8:00 AM until 8:00 PM.
3. The beach is open from 10:00 AM until 6:00 PM from Mid June through Labor Day, and only open and available if lifeguards on duty.
4. The capacity of the large pavilion is no more than 150 people. The capacity of the smaller pavilion is no more than 40 people.
5. Picnic tables in the park are not to be moved into or out of a pavilion, unless authorized by park attendant or other officials.
6. No person under the age of eight (8) shall use the park unless accompanied by a person over the age of fourteen (14).
7. Pets are not permitted in park or beach area.
8. Groups using a pavilion are responsible for their own clean up and are required to leave the area in a cleaner condition than when arriving.
9. The behavior of groups and individuals using a pavilion is the responsibility of the applicant reserving the facility.
10. Please respect the rights and enjoyment of the use of the park of other individuals and parties.
11. Rowdy, loud, unsocial behavior can be cause for ejection from the park. The Town Attendant or other officials have the right and responsibility to take necessary action.
12. Fires permitted only in designated park grills or in commercial or residential grills brought to the Park. No Fires Permitted on the Ground.
